### 2013 Canadian Finals

Discussion at the 2013 CCHA AGM this recent January has revealed that there will be a 2013 CCHA finals. Date is June 6,7, and 8 at OLDS Alberta. **QUALIFYING RULES:** You must be a CCHA Member in the top TEN in Canadian Standings in the 2013 point year. Each Affiliate will use their own point or money tabulation in order to determine the top TEN qualifiers in each class—ties will also be taken to the Finals. You may not double qualify in two Affiliates. Finals run under CCHA Rules. All 12 CCHA Classes will be offered. Entry Forms are included in the Cutter and on the CCHA web site. [www.ccha.ca](http://www.ccha.ca) May 15 will be the deadline for your entries. Your entries must be accompanied by your entry fees. You must fill out the insurance form. All classes will have equal added money except Youth, which will be a \$75 jackpotted class with a \$100 cattle charge. The CCHA finals winners will be determined by a two go round aggregate. **BONUS Go Round Money:** 1st \$300; 2nd \$200. **ADDED MONEY** to each class is \$2000. **THREE HEAD FRESH CATTLE** per cutter

It is important ALL eligible CCHA Members attend this cutting which is put on by the CCHA. In recent years most classes have not been filled. The CCHA needs 20 per class to make this a financially viable event. In recent years the CCHA Finals lost money, primarily due to lack of numbers.

The CCHA has also agreed to hold the 2014 Finals on a date in September. A committee from the AGM is now in the planning stage. Location and details to follow.

## NCHA REP VOTING INFO

Each year, certain NCHA members submit their name to stand as an NCHA Director for a 2 year term. The number of directors in an area or region is determined by the number of NCHA members in the region. In Canada, NCHA Area 20 and 23 members from Manitoba to BC are combined and we are allowed to have one Director for each 75 members. We are now entitled to 7 Directors for the two Areas. Three Directors, Dave Batty, Bob Zirnhelt and Les Timmons are Directors whose term expires next year. Because of increased NCHA membership, instead of 3 Directors, we are now entitled to 4 Directors this year. The 3 incumbent Directors have consented to let their name stand again. In addition, 2 other NCHA members have consented to stand for election. As a result, we will be having an election. Ballots will be mailed to all NCHA members in the two areas. If you have provided an email address to NCHA, you will be contacted by email to vote (a new feature of NCHA rules). If you have not provided an email, you will be receiving a ballot by mail. This is the first time that I can remember where an election has been required in these areas.

As so often happens, we ignore the importance of elections. This time, let's get on board and take the time to vote. Remember, there are 5 candidates on the slate and only four can be elected.

**Messages from Campbell:** OK everybody I have a challenge for all members. The fishing trip that was raffled off last year has been graciously given back as the recipient's cannot go due to personal reasons. They have allowed us to sell the tickets as a fundraiser again. We will be given 30 books, the price will be \$20 dollars per ticket, \$ 10 will go to our BCCHA for every ticket sold. The CCHA has also thrown in an incentive: the affiliate with the most tickets sold will receive \$ 1000 dollars from them. We have approximately 80 members, so if each member sells 1 book or 10 tickets we are "stylin". I will let you know when the books are available and if you want one please let me know or Lynn. Remember these can be sold to anyone as you don't have to be a horse person to like fishing.

### A FEW RULES TO REMEMBER IN THE BCCHA

A competitor must show a minimum of five (5) times to be eligible for any year end awards.

At BCCHA shows there must be at least 2 entries in a class to make the class run. At CCHA and NCHA shows there must be three entrants to make the class run.

When two or more fresh cattle regular classes are combined on the first day of a two day cutting, the order will be reversed on the second show day. Jackpot and used cattle classes will always follow the fresh cattle classes and regular classes.

2 HANDED NOV/NOV – Rider and Horse have earned less than \$500 each, rider must use 2 hands and can rein through run, must use ring snaffle.

\$500 LIMIT RIDER – Rider has earned less than \$500 in any Cutting events, can ride any horse, must ride one handed and all other judging rules apply.

\$500 RANCH HORSE – Any Rider, Horse has earned less than \$500 in any Cutting events, one handed, can stop on ends and all other judging rules apply.

**NEW:** BC JACKPOT Shows DO NOT have a payouts, but contestants will receive points according to the BCCHA payout points schedule.

**NEW:** Weekend memberships are available for \$20 per weekend. POINTS/Payouts **Do Not** count for the BCCHA standings or the CCHA and/or NCHA unless the contestant has purchased the respective membership **PRIOR** to competing.
