- The grounds and the show are not open to the general public. All people entering the grounds are part of a family unit or a barn unit and are showing, loping, or caring for horses.
- No smoking within 15 feet of the Building
- All entry fees must be paid no later than noon Saturday the 29th
- Entries open on BCCCHA website July 30. Entries Close Aug 17
- Book stalls with Michelle—604-819-8583
- Inside barn stalls bedded \$200.00
- Outside covered stalls—\$175.00—one wheelbarrow of shavings will be in stall the rest is self-fill. No charge to stay Sunday night—do not need to clean stalls when you leave. Please do not leave garbage of any kind in stalls.
- Turnback horses are billed same stall rate
- Dry Camping \$15 per night
- If anyone can trailer with a friend it would be greatly appreciated to save parking space
- Cattle in Arena at 7:00A.M. sharp to allow for arena drag due to possible warm dry weather and so we can finish earlier
- Practice Pen & Flag both in Arena. Please give your name to our volunteer. \$25.00 for Flag. \$50.00 cattle practice for 5 min.
- Please clean up after your horse, do not leave horses tied to trailers that dig
- No dogs permitted on grounds
- All jackpot classes will have used cattle. Rhineland Cutlery Pocket Knives for aggregate prizes in those classes!
- NCHA Rule 35 will be in effect over entire grounds
- Classes may be combined to make better herd sizes
- Sat evenings open/non-pro will be to music 🎵
